Starting with the new, highly accessible Eagle Tower and its majestic canopy walk through the trees, the Wisconsin DNR and the Friends of Peninsula State Park have dedicated themselves to making our Park as inclusive as possible. In addition to the tower, since 2019 we have installed all-access beach playground equipment, initiated a trail-ready motorized Track Chair loan out program, and started to make standard wheelchairs available for free use to the public at the Tower.
